	What will my teachers do?	What do I need to do?
When will work be set?	<p><u>Year 7:</u> Upload lesson PPT and other resources twice a week as per schedule lesson.</p> <p><u>Year 8:</u> Set activities to complete in one hour slots (like a lesson) and then upload support material when students need to move onto that specific task.</p> <p><u>Year 9:</u> Work will be set weekly up to Easter to complete current topic. Then following Easter, a new topic (coasts) will be introduced and work set for the next 6 weeks in the form of a booklet. After this the final topic will be skills which will follow the same approach.</p> <p><u>Year 10:</u> Set guidelines what needs to be complete and when on the coast and rivers topic.</p>	<p><u>Year 7:</u> Students to read through the PPT slides and complete a bronze, silver or gold task on lined paper. Also continue to work through the homework tasks.</p> <p><u>Year 8:</u> Students in KS3 will need to complete work on lined paper and use the resources and internet links to help them.</p> <p><u>Year 9:</u> Complete the activities and then work through the booklets after Easter, following the timeline given.</p> <p><u>Year 10:</u> Follow the instructions and advice given by the teacher.</p>
How will work be set?	<p><u>Year 7:</u> All on Google Classroom.</p> <p><u>Year 8:</u> A list of topic criteria will be up loaded on Google Classroom alongside a PPT resource.</p> <p><u>Year 9:</u> Google Classroom and via booklets.</p> <p><u>Year 10:</u> A booklet will be given to students to complete along text book sheets as support.</p>	<p><u>Year 7:</u> Students to read through the PPT slides and complete a bronze, silver or gold task on lined paper. Also continue to work through the homework tasks.</p> <p><u>Year 8 & 9:</u> Use the resources to help you complete the task as much detail as possible. Keep all the work together.</p>
